### Artifacts

- ☐ Choose Quality Artifacts. These include products of learning that you are proud of and matter to you, align with or exceed grade level, and connect to real world issues.
- Add 2 Quality Artifacts to each Skill Folder. Log in to your school Google account. Click on Google Apps (looks like a waffle), select "more," select the Backpack app. You may place artifacts in more than one folder. So, you will have at least 2 artifacts total, but up to 12 (or more, if you want). Most students will need at least 5 artifacts to clearly show their skill range. Use the rubric (on the back) to make sure you meet all the requirements.
- ☐ Complete the reflection component by answering the two alignment questions. These are in the Backpack app, to the right of the assignment image.
